Alaygoo

Also known as Lambda Andromeda III. Planet in the Lambda Andromeda system. Home of the Alaygoons. Possible former Persan colony of Uzshei from Andromeda Galaxy; both slight morphology and linguistic etymology resemblances.

Aleancë

Capital planet of the Pan-Galactic Coalition. Its moon, Armik, is a prison planet similar to Earth's Moon.

Armik is Aleancë's airless moon, very similar to Earth's Moon, and which houses the maximum-security prison for the PGC.

Antares IV

Home of the segmented felinoids

Arcturus VII

Planet in the Arcturus system, known to its inhabitants as Deltir.

Bardothi

Home planet of the Bardothian sponge-rats.

Bast

Home of the Bastians, a felinoid race whose early explorers may be the source of the eponymous Egyptian goddess of their species name.

Beta Ophiuchi 7

Zumbir, omeworld of the Zumbirians. In the Beta Ophiuchi system.

Borscht

A planet in a new star system of the Orion Molecular Cloud Complex, discovered by Alpha One during Omega's pilot training run. It is populated by plant-based creatures, including the principal intelligence on the planet, sapient dire beets. The dire beets are what might be considered "cave beets," in that their development is still rudimentary in terms of culture and technology.

Braxitar

Caltor

A super-Earth in a Jovian-type system. The Caltorians are in an ongoing negotiation with the Ulyffon Alliance, so long that it has become something of a running joke in diplomatic circles, yet is still deadly serious.

Celro

Home of the Celrians. Their most famous citizen is Ari N'Do, a member of the Ennead.

Chesharil

Home of the Chesharilzi.

Corta

A planet in the Sagittarius Dwarf Galaxy, homeworld to the Cortians.

Dabanor

Homeworld of the Dabanorans.

Dekken

Home of the Gurgev.

Deltir

Known on Earth as Arcturus VII. The Deltiri, the natives of Deltir, are telepathic, tall, thin, and while bipedal, have a fish-like look. The most common epidermis color is blue, though there are other colors, including bright teal, purple, bluish shades of green, a purplish-red, and even bright orange, though yellow is not seen as a skin color. They are an advanced culture, highly intelligent, and long-lived.

Delzanth

Homeworld of the Delzantians.

Doukeed

An artificial resort planetoid in the Mu Phoenicis system.

Dryad

Home planet of the Botanoids. In the Embelu system

Home planet for Humans.

Moon

The moon of Earth.

Edeptis IV

Planet in the Edeptis system, on the galactic rim. The Edeptans are short, red skin, yellow eyes. It is a recent signatory to the Sydys Concordat. The planet has areas that are very rich in mineral resources, and grows extremely large corundum and diamond crystals, such that they are often used in slab form as medallions. Other parts of the planet are poorer in resources, however, and may not even have basics like power generation stations. The soil tends to greenish tones, and the foliage tends reddish. Given the inhabitants' genitalia is plant-like, and they possess reddish epidermal layers, it is unknown as yet if they are plant- or animal-based sentients. They are currently classified as Verod in the Gibheer Morphology System, which is a kind of catch-all designation. When more is known about the Edeptan people, this classification may change to a more suitable designation.

Emdali (Draigon)

Homeworld of PGC President Pulgey Entiyti. It is also the homeworld of two separate, but related, sentient races, the Draconans and the Reptoids. Early in the planet's history there was enmity and competition between the two races, but Emdali's most celebrated holiday commemorates the cessation of hostilities and the declaration of peace between Reptoid and Draconan.

Slliith City

Capital of Emdali, aka Draigon.

Home planet of the Ererot. In the Delta Antliae system

Ergis

Homeworld of the Ergisol.

Eriki

Headquarters of Division Two.

Exinul

Home planet of the Exinulans. Also known as GJ 273b or Luyten b. Located in the Luyten's Star system. See also here: https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Luyten_b

Flibitz

A Jovian-like planet. Home of the Tethanoids.

Ganotia

A new signatory planet to the Sydys Concordat. Previously a small star nation comprising several nearby star systems in a cluster, Ganotia was the capital planet.

Gliese 667Cb

The second planet in the Gliese 667C system (part of the trinary Gliese 667).

Haeperg

A super-Earth in the Gliese 581 system; the inhabitants are called Haepergen.

Harriott (Kref)

A planet in the 55 Cancri system. Home of the Krefans and Krefons,

Home of the Virmergin. Located in the HD 10442 system

HD 21749b

Located in the HD 21749 system

Ivalde

Home planet of the Pinnipeds. It is a water world in the Groombridge 34 system.

Europa

A Pinniped mining colony, under the rule of Ivalde, though a moon of Jupiter. It is still in Division One.

The largest gas giant in the Solar System.

A moon of Jupiter. The Pinnipeds have a mining colony on the moon.

Kaceerlon

Homeworld of the eponymous species, in the HD 156411 system.

Kallos

Home of the Kallosians,

Kardor

Home of the Kardorians.

The home system of the Kartung.

Ke!enda!ar

Home of the Ke!endarians.

Kirakalla

AKA Tau Ceti f. Homeworld of the famous "imported" scientist and writer Dr. Travis S. Taylor.

Kochav

Home planet of the Kochavi.

Home of the Korians

Krasnovia

A planet in the Ardrub system, known for its manufacture of excellent waffle irons. On Earth, the name is sometimes used as a 'fictional' place for war games. This is because the officer stationed in D.C. is from the REAL Krasnovia. This has been the source of some confusion on Earth's social media, resulting in an author of some note being temporarily banned for referencing war gaming. (What no one realizes is that he is, himself, from Krasnovia.)

Kufthuria

Kusheer

Homeworld of the Skulians, intelligent seaworms with psuedopod-like antennae.

Kydeen

Homeworld of the eponymous Kydeen people. Their moon, xxx, is somewhat Venus-like, and is home to the exoheteroc species.

Loterus V

Homeworld of the Hypothenemoids.

M'Quer

Homeworld of the M'Querans, Megophiuroids (giant brittle starfish) with a central eye on one side and central mouth on the other. A dispute between the M'Querans and the Veldorn resulted in the hiring of the mercenary Bozheen who became known as Slug.

Ryynqitsk

Homeworld of the eponymous race.

Sluu

Home of the Sluuites. Part of the Nubuv (Kepler-969) system.

Tath

Homeworld of the Tathians, in Division Five. The division's most famous agent is Piradu Madru of Tath.

Tiniken

Also known as Zeta Aurigae Four or Eden. Homeworld of the Tinikeni. The capital city is Preni. Most of the flora and fauna have colors in the blue end of the spectrum.

Tu'Ven

Homeworld of the humanoid Tu'Venites. Capitol city Agra'Thoth.

Unkodiz

Headquarters planet of Division Fourteen.

Va'du'sha'a

Home planet of the Glu'gu'ik. On Earth, it is known as the Zeta[2] Reticuli system, and Va'du'sha'a is the fourth planet in that system.

Va'du'sha'a

Or'da'sha

A Mercury-like world orbiting Zeta[1] Reticuli, known to the Glu'gu'ik. It is uninhabited.

Valestia

Home of Cnáimhseach, the alien midwife.

Veldor

Homeworld of the Veldorn. The planet is not unlike Earth

Wintour

Homeworld of the Wintourns, early galactic explorers. They discovered Earth millennia ago, and given many have elemental powers, were mistaken for gods; the original colonists became the Norse pantheon.

Wontwuun

Homeworld of the Bozheen. In the Delta Scorpil system.

Xem

Home of the Xemlon, a species with four genders.

Yelfflan

Homeworld of the Yelfflani.

Yuvida

Home planet of the Yuvidans. The planet is mostly covered in water.

Zargoth

Homeworld of the Zargothians. A kind of super-Earth. As a result Zargothians are a short, squat, dark gray, powerful race from Zargoth, with extremely thick, dense bones, leatherlike skin, and thick muscle; they are matriarchal, and the female maintains a harem. They are sexually incompatible with humans, because it would kill the human; they have a rasping voice, and are sensitive to vinegar (acid burns).

Zumbir

Home of the Zumbirians. Known to Earth scientists as Beta Ophiuchi 7.

Tuuth

A planet in Division Five.

Kenlinki

A planet in Division Nine.
