Brain Bleacher

Formally, the Cerebellar Holographic Mnemonic Re-Encoding Induction System, more commonly known as 'brain bleach,' this device loosely resembles, and is about the same size of, a conventional smart phone, which is a useful camouflage.

This is the "forget it all" device. Multiple options for its use render it highly adaptable to various situations. These include the wholesale wiping of memories, and the ability to substitute one pre-programmed 'memory' for another, as well as to make up a new 'memory' on the fly. The original memories are recorded in the device's own memory chip for later archiving at Headquarters, so if it is desired to recover the memory for the individual, it can be re-downloaded.

Ergisol Insta-Seal

An instant patch to seal a spacesuit breach, whether rip or puncture. Developed by the Ergisols, hence the name.

Goggle glasses

This sophisticated eyewear looks like standard wraparound sunglasses, but is far more useful. Abilities include, but are not limited to:

- protect against brain bleach
- night vision capability if a button on the left temple is tapped
- targeting/heads-up readouts

Hurgir/Urgir

These are two different, but related, devices. They are Deltiri make, and the names are in common Deltir. Smaller-sized versions of both devices are semi-sentient, and equipped with legs tipped with claws so that the device may cling to the surface upon which it works, and adjust its positioning for maximum efficiency. Large versions are typically on wheels or treads, have cabs, and are Deltiri-driven.

Hurgir

The hurgir is an excavation device, using various fields to adjust the condition of the material being excavated. In some cases, the hurgir removes it, and in others, it simply 'shoves' it to the side, compressing it into the walls of the excavated tunnel. The application of the fields causes a soft blue glow to form between the excavation face of the device and the material being excavated. They are manufactured in every size from pocket-sized up to huge machines that can remove mountains.

Urgir

The urgir is the inverse device from the hurgir. In the cases where the hurgir has simply compressed the excavated matter into the wall of the tunnel, the urgir can decompress it, then smooth over the surface, digitally mapping the adjacent surface and replicating it. This device's field creates a soft green glow between the decompression surface of the device and the material being decompressed. Like the hurgir, it is manufactured in almost every size, though there has been no attempt by the Deltiri to replace a mountain once it has been removed.

Medikit

A portable emergency medical kit for field use. They can be made in varying sizes for ease of carry, depending on mode of transport. A full medikit, such as found in spacecraft, consists of:

- *osmosive micropore hypodermic syringes (no needles required)
- *medscanner
- *burn ointments
- *splints
- *slings
- *gauze
- *tape
- *pads
- *selection of medications, including broad-spectrum antipathogenics and painkillers

Kit Medications

Medications in the kit may include, but are not limited to:

- *pratordicaine -- galactic pharmaceutical, local anesthetic (pill, injection)
- *nobrikazin -- galactic pharmaceutical, sedative (pill, injection)
- *dolocet -- galactic pharmaceutical, NSAID/painkiller (pill)
- *rejuvic -- galactic pharmaceutical, rapid healer (based on an early form of the regen pod fluid) (liquid topical)
- *kelbixlun -- galactic pharmaceutical, epinephrine variant, Kodatin-derived; will not cause heart irregularities or potential organ damage like epinephrine can (injection)
- *pent-ox compound -- galactic pharmaceutical, emergency blood reoxygenator; should be injected into the lung area, avoiding the heart (injection)
- *DeTox tabs -- counters the effects of alcohol and other intoxicating chemicals (pill)
- *imprazine -- galactic pharmaceutical, antihistamine-like immunosuppressant (pill, injection)
- *xolafet -- galactic pharmaceutical, anti-anxiety medication, non-addicting (pill)
- *pentaflexin -- galactic pharmaceutical, broad-spectrum antibiotic (pill, injection)
- *metafloxin -- galactic pharmaceutical, broad-spectrum antibiotic, fast-acting & very powerful (pill, injection)
- *regenic -- a pill form of the regeneration fluid; each prescription is specially-compounded for the patient and the injury/illness in question; a generic version is often made and added to field kits

Pocket Bug Sweeper

This little gold wand loosely resembles a fountain pen such as might have been gifted as a corporate award. It scans the area for signs of clandestine listening/observing devices, locating them by means of a color beacon on the tip. Toggling the function enables the scrambling or other disabling of the 'bug.'

Pocket Electronic Lockpick

This little silver wand loosely resembles a fountain pen such as might have been gifted as a corporate award. It allows for the swift, non-manual picking of both mechanical locks (usually via magnetism) and electronic locks (via reading the electronic state of the locking device and altering it through quantum entanglement).

Pocket Photometric Chemical Analyzer

This tiny device has the ability to read the absorption and emission spectrum of a substance and provide the agent with a readout of its chemical and elemental components.

Data from it is far more detailed, and at a higher resolution, than the scanner app on the smart phones.

Specialized Smart Cell Phones

These resemble normal Earth cell phones but have many more abilities and app features. These include:

- ear buds that tuck inside the ear canal, and are effectively invisible
- subvocal microphones that can hide in the necktie knots or shirt collars and pick up on unvocalized communications via throat and jaw movements
- lots of apps, including but not limited to:
 - a basic spectral-reader-type app which resembles the science scanning device on a certain classic 1960s science fiction TV series
 - games
 - emergency beacon
 - location beacon
 - flashlight
 - beam searchlight
 - control of a personal force field device

Spectral Imaging Scanner

This device identifies aliens in a camouflaged environment (urban or rural) based on morphology & body temperature on a small-screen readout. Similar in size, but not shape, to a larger-size smart cell phone or small tablet reader.

Wrist Chronometers

A watch, and so much more. Functions include:

- atomic chronometer
- localized GPS/positioning system/locator
- metal/weapons detector
- emergency communications (Morse code only)
- emergency detonator
- pocket warp

- emergency power supply
